

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: 08/03/2024 - Ft. Worth, TX TEACHER AND ARTIST, MATTHEW SZAL SENT TO JAIL FOR TWO MONTHS WITH UNANSWERED CALLS & EMAILS ABOUT A DISABLED SECURITY CAMERA AND DESTROYED WORK TRUCK - ALLEGED INHERITANCE FRAUD FROM THE WILL OF GROCERY STORE MAGNATE, JACK KERSTING

Matthew "Magick" Szal was arrested on Nov. 7th, 2023 without a warrant when the police were told false information - Timothy has been gaslighting Matthew because of an alleged one million dollar inheritance fraud scheme pulled off by him and former neighbor/banker, Frank "Keith" Bufano.

Matthew Szal arrived home from running errands and was tackled by five Southlake Police officers, who arrested him without a warrant and planted illegal evidence on him. Matthew was jailed for two months and called/emailed the Southlake Police Department several weeks earlier about a video of Timothy Szal disabling his security camera. The truck he used for his side business, a mobile mechanic service called "Magick Mechanic", had the transmission fluid drained along with other visible damage to the engine block.

Matthew was engaged to Jack Kersting's daughter, Leigh Ellen. Jack made his millions owning several grocery stores around the Charleston, South Carolina area. Matt inherited a million dollars, yet since Jack died during the Pandemic, it made it possible for Timothy Szal to intercept a certified letter. After a cursory investigation it appears that Frank Bufano (Matthew's former neighbor) was able to help launder the money and move it to offshore accounts as a "successful" banker. He is also suspected of offering Mafia ties and experience in this illegal behavior.

Matthew's former business partner, Vanessa Arevalo, is missing and suspected dead because of this situation. Matthew has survived several attempts on his life with no answer from the various F.B.I reports about this situation.
