Magick quits Warren Tire

Matthew "Magick" Szal quit Warren Tire on Oct.7 after hearing about allegations of a connection between the owners, Bob/Wayne Kellogg, and groups supported by the Russian Military and V. Putin (pictured above). Congresswoman Beth Van Duyne has spearheaded an investigation into the matter. Magick does freelance graphic design work for GOP and DNC clients, such as Beth Van Duyne, Cruz, Biden, Abbott and Newsom.

An attempt to fire Matthew Szal happened almost two months ago when the manager of the Latham Warren Tire tried to fire Matt for not wanting to work after he was in a severe car wreck. The district manager moved him to the Schenectady store. Matt requested Warren Tire sponsor his foundation, which would send war orphans to boarding schools and remove them from the refugee camps. His request was denied, and it is clear that certain groups are trying to prevent humanitarian aid from going to these areas.

After a few months, Timothy Szal & Frank Bufano possibly offered the new store manager and district manager a substantial bribe. After becoming aware of this, Matt requested that they accept the money and they would try "to pull a fast one." After this request to pretend to fire him was denied, along with the pursuits for his foundation and pressure from his business partner Will Valk of Magick Mechanic, he quit.

Matt has two active civil lawsuits against Timothy Szal and Frank Bufano. In the suit with Frank Bufano, the plaintiff is Matt's LLC, Magick Mechanic. A cursory investigation has revealed that stolen money was used to bribe officials on state and federal levels. Thankfully for Beth Van Duyne, Magick was saved from further harassment. His foundation will sponsor at least 100 kids aged 10-14 to attend boarding school and leave the refugee camps. It will be funded by apartment rental properties purchased to make it sustainable.
